Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce: Katie Bruce: The Parade of Lights is tonight with line-up starting at 5:15pm. The route will be the same as last year and the Salty Steer will be having a free chili feed and kids dance following the parade. The catholic church is also having their Mexican feast starting at 6:00pm. The Holiday Sweepstakes is underway and we have started doing small weekly drawings.
