President Kraut gave her report and financial review for 2023.

Director Katie Bruce advised the 2023 Year in Review was included in the meeting packet and if there were any questions to please ask at any time. Upcoming events of City Wide Clean Up, Wall Airport Re-Opening & Fly-In, and 605 Day were discussed.


