

January 14, 2025

Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce Board Vice-President Liliya Stone called the meeting to order at 12:05 PM and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Susie Radigan-Kjerstad, second by Jody Bielmaier to approve meeting minutes from the December luncheon. Motion carried. Motion by Jody Bielmaier to approve the Treasurer's Report, second by Carol Hodge. Motion carried.

Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce: Katie Bruce: We gave out \$4200 in the Holiday Sweepstakes this year and those Wall Bucks are all in my office ready to be picked up. Thank you to everyone for participating and to all the businesses for taking the time to fill the cards out. We appreciate it as this is a very fun promotion that the community enjoys. We had planned on hosting our Spring cornhole party again this year however we have decided to delay it out of consideration of the Shriners benefit for Ada Pelton which also includes a cornhole tournament. We will have more information on that after our next meeting.

**City of Wall:** Mary Williams: Thank you to businesses and residents who are clearing sidewalks and walkways of snow. A complaint was received from those walking to work and we want to make sure those residents can get around town safely. Building permit numbers were compiled and the city invested in infrastructure and now new homes are being built in our community. There are still lots available to build homes on in Wall and Cheyenne has a builder very interested in building in Wall. Sales tax for 2024 was down \$106,000 which made the city budget very tight. BBB tax was up over \$11,000 for 2024.

**Wall Economic Development:** Dawn Hilgenkamp: Rochan is attending meetings at Elevate today. They have been doing board training and there will be a meeting with partners about what the community needs. There was a meeting with the event center committee and they are looking for land to build a youth center for activities. Anyone who has items for newsletters please send them to Rochan. She will also be scheduling business visits to learn what businesses need. There is a revolving loan fund available for investors. There is also a tax rebate

available on new homes built in Wall through the city for 5 years, this also includes the industrial park. The first coffee connect will be Feb 12<sup>th</sup> at 9AM at First Interstate Bank and it will be covering HR. minefields. If anyone would like a copy of the newsletter, please let Rochan know.

**National Grasslands Visitor Center:** Kelsey Bean: They will be having a booth at the tourism conference next week. There is a job open and posted at the visitor center. They will be hosting the National Grasslands Manager Meeting here in Wall at the community center in May.

**Rodeo Booster Club**: Dawn Hilgenkamp: they have a meeting on Wednesday to vote to hire contractors for summer events.

**HS Rodeo:** Dawn Hilgenkamp: They have 6-7 kids who have qualified to compete in the 20X rodeo during the Stock Show.

**Wall Ambulance District:** Liliya Stone: In 2024 there were 172 calls for service. 81 of these calls were transports. This summer there will be an EMT class in Wall. This will be a free class, limited to 10 people. It will be from June-Sept on Tues & Thurs evenings from 6-10 PM. There will be an informational meeting in March.

**Wall Community Library:** Linda Hiltner: They have a board meeting tomorrow with an election of officers. They have 2 vacancies on the board and are looking for new members.

**Golden West:** Jody Bielmaier: Happy New Year to everyone, Golden West has delivered scholarship applications to schools so seniors should reach out to school counselors. The deadline is March 14<sup>th</sup>.

**West River Electric**: Dawn Hilgenkamp: Scholarships available for seniors and the deadline is 1/29 and you can apply online.


